ESPRESSO MARTINI

£6.95

Stolichnaya vanilla vodka, Caffè Espresso, Tosolini liqueur and a shot of espresso shaken together for an iced coffee kick

WHITE RUSSIAN

£6.95

Caffè Espresso, Tosolini liqueur layered with Finlandia vodka, double cream and dusted with toasted chocolate

RASPBERRY RIPPLE MARTINI

£6.95

Stolichnaya Vanilla vodka and Chambord, shaken with half & half, drizzled with Grenadine

DESSERT WINES & PORT

MUSCATO D'ASTI DOCG

125ml £4.95

Made with sweet Muscato grapes from the Morelli vineyard. Straw yellow with greenish hints, and a distinctive fragrance of fruit and honey. A superb sweet wine

MALVASIA DI CASTELNUOVO DON BOSCO DOC

125ml £4.45

Made with an ancient aromatic grape variety from the Piedmont region. Cherry red, with pleasant aromatic notes of wild rose and raspberry. Delicious chilled and a great match for pastry, red fruit or hazlenuts

TAYLORS LBV

50ml £4.55

Late Bottled Vintage, as the name suggests, is bottled much later than other ports, remaining in wood for between four and six years. This port has an intense purple ruby colour with a pungent aromatic nose with heaps of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum. Lovely clean, crisp freshness to the bouquet

MALT WHISKY

GLENGOYNE 10YR

£4.95

The Glengoyne distillery is situated at Dumgoyne, north of Glasgow and is unique in producing a Highland single malt whisky that is actually matured in the Lowlands. Slightly herbal with a big bourbon influence which has brought a wonderful "high note" with white milk bottle sweets, more creamy than fruity

JURA 10YR

£4.75

The Isle of Jura is just East of Islay and Jura 10YR is the only malt distilled on the island and has been bottled there since 1810. It has fresh notes of damp hay and soft, malty cereal notes with a touch of peat with gentle oak and arak with blossom tones

GLENLIVET FOUNDERS RESERVE

£4.25

The Glenlivet distillery is near Ballindalloch in Moray and is the oldest legal distillery in the parish of Glenlivet being founded in 1824. Some dates then slightly sharp plum and apricot wine note. There's orange zest, toffee, hints of struck match and chocolate raisins

AUCHENTOSHAN 12YR

£4.95

The name Auchentoshan is from Gaelic 'Achadh an t-Oisein' which translates as "the field of the corner". The Distillery is West of Glasgow in Dalmuir and has been producing this fine malt since 1823. A little fruity yet it has some dry woodiness. A touch of smokiness with a little sweetness at the end

DALMORE 12YR

£4.75

Founded in 1839 'The Dalmore' distillery is located in Alness, which is 20 miles North of Inverness and sits on the banks of the Cromarty Firth overlooking the Black Isle. Roasted coffee beans, the oily nuttiness in a fine espresso, there are little notes of malt and cereal and butter with rich orange

ABERFELDY 12YR

£4.95

Aberfeldy Distillery was founded by the John Dewar & Sons, Ltd. in 1896, and opened in 1898. The distillery is located on the eastern outskirts of Aberfeldy, on the southern bank of the upper Tay. Creamy with some sherried fruit and a trailing hint of smoke. Sweet, malty, a gentle peat but nonetheless the mouth feel is very clean

DEWAR'S 12YR

£4.75

Hailing from the same distillers as Aberfeldy 12YR this popular and well-loved whisky is definitely one to try. A heady note of juicy fruit and thick, creamy malt. Rather floral and quite sweet with notes of toasted barley, almond and a tinge of honey

TALISKER 10YR

£5.45

Founded in 1830 by Hugh and Kenneth MacAskill at Carbost, the distillery was rebuilt 1880–87 and extended in 1900. Talisker is one of the Classic Six Malts of Scotland.

A classic from the Isle of Skye and always highly rated with lots of spice and fresh, tangy peat. Thick, pungent smokiness with notes of kippers, seaweed, and apple peels; fresh and fragrant

BUNNAHABHAIN 12YR

£5.25

Situated on the North East shore of Islay, Bunnahabhain was founded in 1881 by William Robertson and brothers, James and William Greenless. The name is derived from the Gaelic for 'mouth of the river'.

This 12 year old is lightly peated for an Islay single malt and consequently is a light, fresh dram. Now at the higher strength of 46.3% for more complexity and flavor with fresh seaweed, malt with a sherried mochaccino finish

GLENKINCHIE 12YR

£4.95

Founded in 1837, the Glenkinchie distillery is found in Pencaitland, East Lothian and is one of the six distilleries in the Lowland region.

Light, yet fragrant with notes of fresh cereal and some barley sweetness. There is a freshness and roundness to this dram. The finish is of medium length with notes of fresh greenness

GLENFIDDICH 15YR

£5.95

Glenfiddich is a Speyside single malt, owned and produced by William Grant & Sons in Dufftown. Glenfiddich means 'Valley of the Deer' in Gaelic.

Matured in American bourbon, Portuguese sherry and virgin oak barrels. The whisky is then married in a Solera vat giving it notes of sherry, citrus-orange in particular, dry wood with slight suggestion of smoke

GLENMORANGIE LA SANTA 12YR

£5.75

Glenmorangie distillery is in Tain, Ross-shire. Founded in 1843 and now owned by the Louis Vuitton-Moët Hennessy Group.

Cream and caramel, crème Anglaise and chocolate raisins and quite dry with notes of mixed sweet spices

LAGAVULIN 16YR

£6.95

The distillery of Lagavulin officially dates from 1816 when John Jonston and Archibald Campbell constructed two distilleries on the site. One of them became Lagavulin and is another of the classic six malts of Scotland

A much sought-after single malt with the massive peat-smoke that's typical of southern Islay and one of the smokiest noses on the island with a long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke and vanilla

GRAPPA

The story Tosolini is above all the story of one family starting from the Patriarch's inspirational muse, his beloved wife, Giovanna

Now run by Giovanni, the eldest son who works to the same production philosophy as his father, still uses steam powered stills, with only a token nod to the modern world. The production, aging, refining times and rules have remain unaltered and are now being carried on by his own children

CIVIDINA

£3.50

This is produced from a combination of grape varieties grown in Friuli and distilled entirely in pot stills.

Intensely floral nose with geraniums and tobacco and a sweet, honey-blossom palate

GRAPPA DI MOSCATO

£4.25

The only Tosolini grappa distilled from a single grape variety, made exclusively from Moscato

Powerful and very Moscato-like with notes of grapes and lemon zest

AGRICOLA

£4.95

This Agricola is distilled using the fresh pomace of red wine grapes from selected vineyards

Intense aromas and flavours of ripe black fruit

STAGIONATA FRASSINO

£5.25

A special grappa from Tosolini, Frassino refers to the type of cask used for maturation and is made using wood from the ash tree rather than the more usual oak

Pale yellow in colour with notes of fresh almonds, honey and raisins

TOCAI CASTAGNO

£8.50

Another fabulous aged grappa made from Tocai pomace by renowned producers Tosolini. The twist here is that Barrique Castagno means 'chestnut barrel', which of course is extremely unusual

An exceptionally smooth grappa, more akin to Cognac. With notes of vanilla, figs and far away spices leaving it delicate on the palate
